

Treasurer's Report

Sue said the Port returned the club's \$1,500 deposit. There were 217 cars registered in the show; 55 of them were Pontiacs. Expenses included the DJ, the Port for reserved parking, the U-Haul truck rental, and prizes. The coffee and donuts paid for themselves. Trophy donations were \$940 (cost for the trophies was \$1,100), and \$1,800 was collected from sponsorships. There were 158 cars pre-registered and 59 additional entered the day of the show. Altogether, 28 trophies were awarded.

Sue thanked everyone who worked as volunteers and shared that the club received many compliments from attendees.

Income from the gate will be split between our club and the Police Museum. Each year our club donates to Fisher House and Fleet Week. This year each will receive \$1,700.

Keeping The Pontiac Legacy Alive...

Formed in 1972 by a small group of enthusiasts who wanted to pool as much Pontiac and Oakland information as was possible, the first convention was held the following year in Camp Hill, Pennsylvania. Since then, POCI chapters have formed all over the country and POCI Conventions have been held every year in a variety of locations. The events include a car show, tech seminars, presentations, drag racing and a great swap meet. GMC trucks were included in 1998, due to their close relation to Pontiac.






