

We met up at Roland and Janet's house in El Cajon for the cruise to AZ!





RECREATING THE LOST 'BLUE CAR'

CHAPTER 14



We are pleased to bring the next chapter of a series on Greg Raymond's restoration project to build a Tribute to the Royal Bobcat Blue Car from the March 1964 Car and Driver road test. This month's chapter highlights how far Greg is taking this tribute project to be as close to the original Blue Car as ordered by Jim Wangers for the Car and Driver "Face-off" with a Ferrari GTO. Aptly named, Say It's Worth It is provided here for your reading pleasure.

So when the story starts to hit home... the vision changes. Not so much as to the build, but as to the personal experience.

In December of 1963 when my father visited Peelies Pontiac in Highland Falls, New York with my grandfather to order the 1964 GTO Convertible which remains in my family today, my father requested one option that was declined by my Grandfather. This option was code #N34, a costume sports steering wheel which came in at \$39.27.



My father told the story over and over about how bad he wanted this option but conceded to my grandfathers wishes. Today his 1964 GTO still retains the factory red steering wheel which I clinch with pride as I enjoy every mile I add to my family's legacy.

Jim Wangers made sure both of the Car and Driver cars submitted for the feature had this simulated wood grain steering wheel option. This photo of the Blue Car shows it in all of it's glory.



The custom sports wheel, Looks like wood but isn't. Stainless steel spokes. Optional, Four round, easy-to-read dials, optional technicator on right.

So here is where we get to the, "Is it Worth it" chapter heading. My father paid just \$2796 for my family's 1964 GTO convertible. For those who know, OEM factory Pontiac option code #N34 custom sports steering wheels are not just hard to find, but when on the market chime in at just about what my father paid for the entire GTO in December of 1963!

So while I resisted the addition of the option that my Father dreamed of over 60 years ago to our car, I now had the chance to make the decision for myself, for Jim Wangers and the legacy that is the 1964 Pontiac GTO Pilot Car used in the Car and Driver article.






